Extra Support

Extra support for those with specific educational needs will be charged at £32 per session of additional support.

EAL Support

EAL (English as an Additional Language) will be charged at £32 per session of language support.

Different rates may be charged for Extra Support and EAL when the amount of help received is greater or lesser than the standard provision.

Individual Instrumental Tuition/LAMDA Lessons

Individual Instrumental Tuition takes place during class time. Current fees are £290 per term per instrument. LAMDA lessons are charged at a rate of £245 per term for weekly individual lessons and £148 per student for paired lessons. Half a term's notice must be given of intention to withdraw from these lessons.

Public Examination

Public Examination fees will be billed at the time of exam entry.

Please note: Fees are set for the whole year, and reviewed annually. Any change in fees will normally be announced at the end of the Spring term and will take effect from the following September. Fees are invoiced in three installments throughout the academic year.

Deposit and Fees

A deposit of £500 should be paid to the school on acceptance of a place. This will be held for the duration of your child's time at the school and will be refunded when the final fee account has been paid. In the case of pupils living outside the UK a deposit equivalent to one term's fees is required.

Fees are payable three working days prior to the beginning of term. An interest charge of 5% will be made on all outstanding accounts after this date unless special arrangements have been made in advance. Where special arrangements have not been made, any pupil whose fees are still outstanding by the beginning of term may be asked not to attend school until such time as their account is cleared in full. Please see our Terms & Conditions for further information.

Charges for extras appear on the account for the following term. Please note charges in excess of £25 will require parental approval.

SCHOLARSHIPS AND BURSARIES

Sibford awards general academic scholarships as well as subject specific scholarships for Art, Music and Sport. Scholarships consist of a maximum 10% discount on fees which may be supplemented by a means tested bursary. Scholarships are made for the following Year groups:

- Senior School for entry to Year 7 (offered until the end of Year 11)
- Senior School for entry to Year 9 (offered until the end of Year 11)
- Sixth Form for entry to Year 12 (offered until the end of Year 13)

Sibford School also offers a limited number of means tested bursaries to both Quaker and non-Quaker families.
